

Using Search to Quickly Find Patient Information in the Documents Domain

The Elastic Search function allows you to search for information in the Documents domain by typing full or partial terms within the Search. This is particularly useful when a patient has numerous documents, as it guides you to the document and relevant section of the document you are looking for.


- Use sticky search to quickly locate the most relevant document and section without re-entering your search term.
- Search term remains active while navigating through patient documents.

Search for Patient Information

Use sticky search functionality to quickly find relevant patient information.

Step 1 | Search for patient information

1. Open the Documents domain, then click into the Search bar and type in your full or partial term, then press Enter.
2. Sticky search results will appear in yellow highlighted in both the Document cards and the Document details window of the selected card.
