

Identifying new patient information is available – Notifications and Badges

Discover how Notifications keep you alerted to new patient information from other health services and how badges highlight critical clinical or demographic data within CareSync Exchange.

Step 1 | Review the CareSync Exchange Notification Alert

Patient Notifications are displayed on the widget.

If a counter appears on the bell (notification icon), it is alerting you to new patient information from other health services within the last 30-days is available.

Where a patient is behind break glass, no notifications will be visible until after the break glass has been performed.







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Step 2 | Open the Notification list

Click the **bell icon** to open the pop-out pane containing the Patient Notifications List. New information will be listed starting with the most current date.

Each item in the Notification List is shown as a Notification Card.



Within each **Notification Card** the following information will be displayed:

A. Date

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- B. Completion Status
- C. Name of the Notification item, sometimes followed by a facility name or location

- D. A comment, diagnoses list, conclusion or description.

Any item displayed in **bold** red font signifies an abnormal result, ensuring that critical new information is not overlooked.





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Understanding Patient Indicator Badges



The Notification list may also have **Patient Indicator badges** appearing on the Patient Banner.



The **Patient Indicator badges** used within CareSync Exchange include the following:

ED	Emergency Department	The ED and IP badges appear if the patient has a hospital visit of these types within the past 12 months including any current presentations/admissions. Patient data will include all health services.
VIP	Protected Patient	Upon `Breaking glass' the VIP badge will be visible on the Patient Banner as per the ED and IP badges.
	Note: The VIP badge will <i>never</i> appear on the CareSync Exchange widget.	In a future iteration of CareSync Exchange, VIP will be rebadged as 'PP'.
